# NOTICE TO THE DEPOSITORS OF THE CLOSED RURAL BANK OF BAROTAC VIEJO (ILOILO), INC.

Following the expiration of the temporary restraining order (TRO) and/or status quo ante order (SQAO) issued by the Court of Appeals (19th Division in Cebu City), the PHILIPPINE DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION (PDIC) immediately resumed its deposit insurance operations for the closed RURAL BANK OF BAROTAC VIEJO (ILOILO), INC. to settle deposit insurance claims. The following shall apply to the depositors of the bank who have not filed claims or received payment for deposit insurance.

Depositors whose deposit balances amount to PHP100,000.00 and below and who have no outstanding loans with the closed bank, have not acted as co-makers of these obligations, are not spouses of the borrowers, have updated and complete mailing address in the bank record through the PDIC-provided Mailing Address Update Form (MAUF), and have not maintained the account under the name of business entities, are not required to file claims. They may proceed directly to their local post offices starting May 25, 2017 to claim their deposit insurance via postal money orders (PMOs). PMOs amounting to PHP15,000.00 and below may be encashed with the local post office or with any branch office of the Land Bank of the Philippines.

All other depositors, regardless of the type of their account or account balance, have to file deposit insurance claims, as follows:



#### **Personally**

### **REMINDERS**

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR FILING CLAIMS

- latest bank statement.
- 2. One (1) VALID ORIGINAL PHOTO-BEARING IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT (ID) with signature of depositor (e.g. Driver's License, SSS/GSIS ID, Senior Citizen's ID, Passport, PRC ID, OWWA/OFW ID, Seaman's ID, Alien Certificate of Registration ID, Voter's ID). However, depositors are encouraged to present at least two (2) valid IDs in case of discrepancy in signature.
- 3. For depositors below eighteen (18) years old, photocopy of Birth Certificate from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) or duly certified copy issued by the Local Civil Registrar.
- 4. Original copy of a notarized/authenticated Special Power of Attorney (SPA) of depositor or parent of a minor depositor, if claimant is not the signatory in the bank records. A copy of the SPA may be downloaded from the PDIC website, http://www.pdic.gov.ph/files/spa\_claims.pdf.
- 5. Accomplished Claim Form, downloadable from http://www.pdic.gov.ph/files/New\_PDIC\_Claim\_Form.pdf, if filed through mail.

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
