DEFINITION

1. PROGRAM (BESF) - A homogeneous group of activities necessary for the performance of a major purpose for which a government agency is established, for the basic maintenance of the agency's administrative operations or for the provisions of staff support to the agency's administrative operations or for the provisions of staff support to the agency's line functions.
2. PROJECT (BESF) - Special agency undertakings which are to be carried out within a definite time frame and which are intended to result in some pre-determined measure of goods and services.
3. PMO/End User - Unit as proponent of program or project
4. Mode of Procurement - competitive bidding and alternative methods including: selective bidding, direct contracting, repeat order, shopping, and negotiated procurement.
5. Schedule for Each Procurement Activity - Major procurement activities (advertising/posting; submission and receipt/Opening of bids award of contract; contract signing).
6. Source of Funds - whether GoP, Foreign Assisted or Special Purpose Fund
7. Estimated Budget - Agency approved estimate of project/program costs
